The project focuses on the molecular basis of adaptation and persistence of the opportunistic pathogenic bacterium *Acinetobacter baumannii* to its eukaryotic host. Our research is funded by several grants of the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft in the framework of the DFG Research Unit FOR2251 (Director Prof. Dr. Volker Müller, [www.acinetobacter.de](http://www.acinetobacter.de)). We offer a highly stimulating and productive environment of a large research unit and state of the art methods in all areas of microbiology, biochemistry, genetics and infection biology.

We are seeking highly self-motivated individuals with a background in bacterial infection biology with excellent references and publication record. Expertise in biochemical and genetic methods is required. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to establish and develop their own research group in the field of *Acinetobacter* biology. Teaching is required and the candidate must be able to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in microbiology.
