The position is offered for two years.

### JOB DESCRIPTION

Your main task will be the establishment of a competence Network strengthening the application of sequencing technology for fast resistance prediction and surveillance in high incidence settings in Eastern Europe, Central Asia and Africa. The aim of the project is to establish a sustainable competence network in Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Namibia and Mozambique to promote the application of sequencing technology (partly NGS) for rapid TB resistance diagnosis and monitoring. Core work contents are the technology transfer (classical sequencing or NGS technology, diagnostic workflows) and the establishment of local competence centres including the training of experts for data management, analysis and interpretation within the countries.
